

# Corton Grand Cru "Les Renardes" AOC Corton Grand Cru, Bourgogne, France

# THE VINTAGE

965 bottles, 30 magnums and 3 jeroboams have been produced for the vintage 2018.

## LOCATION

0.3 hectares of vines planted in 1956.

This plot sits mid-slope on the hill of Corton. It faces southeast and is considered to be one of Corton's most prestigious.

#### TERROIR

These vines grow on very chalky soil on the lower part of the hillside with much more clay on the upper part; the opposite on the rest of the Côte de Beaune. This is due to a limestone fault in the middle of the plot which has resulted in lots of limestone mother rock outcrops on the lower part of the slope.

#### WINEMAKING

Harvesting is manual with 40% of whole clusters. 3 weeks of fermentation with very light extraction.

#### AGEING

60% of new oak barrels are used for an aging period of 20 months.

## VARIETAL

Pinot Noir 100%

#### TASTING

This wine is always very lively thanks to the strong presence of limestone in the soil. It is racy and powerful, with great depth.
