



Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru "Aux Charmes"

AOC Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru, Bourgogne, France

A very elegant wine with a vigor that reflects the terroir



LOCATION

This plot of 0.3 hectares was planted in 1954 and is located on the upper part of the Charmes-Chambertin terroir known as "Aux Charmes". Running alongside the Route des Grands Crus between Morey-Saint-Denis and Gevrey-Chambertin, this plot is opposite the border between Latricières Chambertin and Chambertin itself.

TERROIR

Its singular geology composed of Jurassic marl and limestone results in wines with unique finesse and generosity. It is usually vinified with around 70% in whole bunches to foster tension and freshness in the wine.
